Faculty,

The meet and confer issues gathering process is moving forward. A total of 413 faculty responded to the issues gathering survey. The responses, grouped by college, are listed on the Faculty Association website (<http://mccfa.wildapricot.org/Default.aspx?pageId=1669245>). Faculty senate presidents have been provided the list of individual responses for their colleges including the e-mail addresses of the respondents. This will allow presidents to follow up with the faculty who submitted issues, as needed. Here is the planned timeline.

Aug 29 - Sep 9: Senates will be working to identify the top three issues for the faculty at their college.

Sep 10: Faculty Executive Council (FEC) will meet and prioritize the issues submitted by the senates. FEC, as an elected representative body, will make a recommendation to the Meet and Confer Team faculty as to what issues should be pursued this year.

Sep 11 – Sep 23: Meet and Confer Team faculty in consultation with the FEC leadership consider FEC recommendations and make final determination on what issues to bring forward

Aug 23 – Sep 23: The administrative members of the Meet and Confer Team collect and prioritize issues from their constituents.

Sep 23: Administrative and faculty representatives on the Meet and Confer Team exchange issues lists

Sep 24 – Oct 2: Faculty may provide feedback on proposed issues lists

Oct 3 - Oct 4: Meet and Confer Team faculty and FEC leadership consider issue feedback from faculty

Oct 7 – Oct 21: Meet and Confer Team evaluates issues and negotiates issues to work in 2013 – 2014

As we reach the various milestones, the appropriate documents will be posted on the Faculty Association website.

Throughout this year, I will be sending out monthly Meet and Confer Minutes to keep you all informed as to the progress of the negotiations. Thank you for your continued support.
