#### **INFORMATION ABOUT THIS GRANT**

- This application and grant award are for MCCCCD students with Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) status that are affected by the increase in tuition rates for Arizona community colleges. - Applications must be complete to be considered for funding. Applicants who submit incomplete applications will be notified and allowed to complete their applications. Applications will be marked as complete on the date when all supporting paperwork is received.
- Complete applications will be considered for any available funding in the order they are received (or completed).
- The maximum amount awarded is the difference between the in-state and out-of-state tuition at the respective institution. It does not cover *in-state tuition*, fees, books, or other related expenses. Grant checks are written directly to the institution.
- The application and all *required* documentation are kept confidential. FERPA protections apply to the educational institutions.
- You will be notified *by email* when your application is received and the status of your application.
