INFORMATION ABOUT THIS GRANT

- This grant is for students with Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) status affected by the change in Arizona tuition rates for community colleges and state universities.
- The grant is awarded as the difference between the in-state and out-of-state tuition at the respective institution and does not include fees, books, or other related expenses. Grant checks are written directly to the institution.
- Funding priority is given to students who are close to completing a program of study (degree or certificate). Grants awarded on a case-by-case basis and are subject to available funding.
- All information about students requesting and receiving grants will be kept confidential by the granting organizations. FERPA protections apply to the educational institutions.
